

Post-Op Instructions For In-Office Procedures

- ELEVATE FOR 1-2 HOURS AFTER PROCEDURE
- Stay off your feet as much as possible today
- Wear your surgical shoe whenever weight bearing
- The surgical area may remain numb for up to 1-2 hours after the procedure
- Slight bleeding, discoloration and drainage are normal
- Elevate your foot to help alleviate minor swelling, bleeding and discomfort
- Ice near the area for 5-10 minutes at a time
- If you were given prescription pain medicine and it is not helping then contact our office
- Leave the surgical bandage clean, dry and intact for the first 4 days after your procedure
 - If the bandage sticks to the area, dampen it with water or shower/bathe with the bandage in place. This will make it easier to remove with minimal or no discomfort.
 - o After you remove the bandage you can shower over your stitches
 - o Place a new Band-Aid over the incision
- Monitor your surgical site for any signs of infection including redness, swelling, and pain that continues to worsen after the surgery
- Monitor for any color changes to your toe(s)
