

Post-Op Instructions Following Nail / Wart Surgery

- ELEVATE FOR ½ HOUR AFTER PROCEDURE
- Stay off your feet as much as possible today
- You may wear any shoe, sandal or open toe footwear that does not squeeze, constrict or put pressure on your foot or toe(s)
- The surgical area may remain numb for up to 1-2 hours after the procedure.
- Slight bleeding, discoloration and drainage are normal
- Elevate your foot for 30 minutes after surgery to help alleviate minor swelling, bleeding and discomfort
- Ice near the area for 5-10 minutes at a time
- Removing the surgical bandage:
 - o The day after surgery, carefully remove the dressing and shower (or bathe) as normal.
 - o If the bandage sticks to the area, dampen it with water or shower/bathe with the bandage in place. This will make it easier to remove with minimal or no discomfort.
- Changing the dressing:
 - o After showering/bathing, blot the surgical site and air dry for 10 minutes
 - o Apply a small amount of wound dressing directly to the surgical area
 - o Cover <u>nail surgeries</u> with a loose fabric bandaid
 - O Cover wart surgeries with a bandaid and/or gauze
 - o Stinging may occur and is normal
 - o Continue this twice per day until your follow up visit
 - o Do not use peroxide on the surgical area
 - o Do not soak the surgical site
